If left untreated, a staggering 30% of chronic wounds will result in amputation, and after an amputation, the five-year mortality rate is approximately 50%.

Regular skin checks — including feet, legs, ankles, surgical sites, and pressure areas — combined with professional wound evaluations, help identify problems early, especially when wounds are slow to heal, worsen, or show signs of infection. Advanced wound therapies that support healing and tissue growth may include total contact casting, negative pressure wound therapy, and hyperbaric oxygen therapy.
