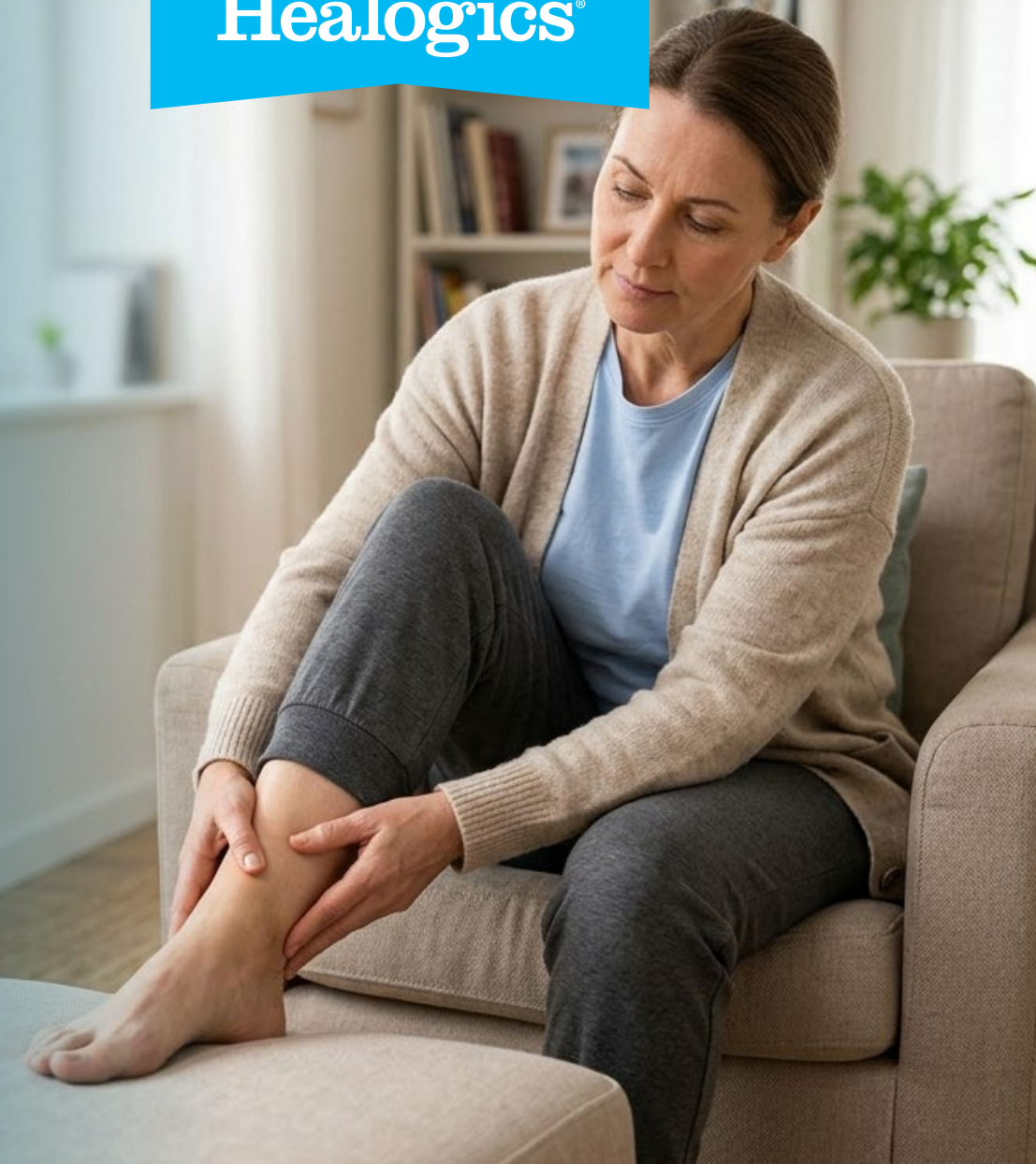

### CARE

Advanced wound care treatments may include **debridement, total contact casting or offloading, cellular tissue products, negative pressure wound therapy, and hyperbaric oxygen therapy.**
